## PROJECTS

### Question 1:

- Please indicate the number of projects delivered **entirely** in the morning OR afternoon OR evening. Where a project is delivered in a **combination** of morning, afternoon and/or evening sessions each week it should be recorded as mixed.

### Question 2:

- A student should be counted only **once** regardless of whether or not she/he attended one or more than one ITABE project over the period January 2011 to December 2011.

### Question 3:

- The total number of students who have completed more than one single 84 hour ITABE programme.

## PARTICIPANTS

### Question 4 and 5

- This relates to students identified in the Application Form under the target groups OR as declared by the student. Should a group of students come through a referral organisation then the information may be obtained through that organisation.

### Question 6:

- This refers to the highest level of education achieved by the student before taking part in an ITABE project at the point of enrolment.

### Question 8:

- A student is deemed to have completed a project if he or she was still attending sessions/classes when the 14 week period came to an end, **regardless** of whether or not he/she enrolled for a follow up ITABE programme.

## ASSESSMENT

### Questions 9:

- This information can be gleaned from the ITABE pre-course assessments. If a student is assessed at Level 1.3 or less she/he is working towards a standard equivalent to NFQ/FETAC Level 1, etc.
- These levels **are not related to whether or not the student is seeking accreditation** but rather refer to a standard indicated in the ITABE assessment process.
- **This information may form part of the ITABE Application 2012**

## ACCREDITATION

### Question 10:

- This refers to the number of students who **enrolled** in ITABE projects where it was agreed that the student would work towards **accreditation**.
- This refers to students who have actually presented their portfolios and have **actually achieved accreditation** while taking part in ITABE projects during the year.

## LEVEL INCREASE Post Course Summary

### Question 11:

- This refers to the **Post Course Assessment Summary Sheet** in the Assessment Pack where it has been identified that the student has progressed in levels from the **first** Pre-Course Assessment to the **last Post-Course Assessment 2011** regardless of how many ITABE projects the student completed.
